Final stage: Maximum of 78 players

# Course / distances For both stages, course played will be from white tee distances (except hole n°13 from black tee distances). Yardage book (only in meters and included in the entry fee) will be available at the tournament office (one book per player; if you need a second one, the cost will be 27€ in cash or cheque).

#### FORMAT

## First stage: 36 holes Stroke play - 18 holes a day

A minimum of 15 players will be qualified for the Final Stage. The number of players qualifying to proceed to the Final Stage will be announced after the start of the first round. In case of ties, a hole-by-hole playoff will determine the selected players. Playoff will take place as soon as possible after the end of regular play.

## Final stage: 54 holes Stroke play - 18 holes a day

Cut after 36 holes – 40 players and ties qualified to play the final round.

At the conclusion of the 54 holes the leading 40 players and ties will be ranked according to their scores.

Trolleys / Electric trolleys / Buggies	40 trolleys available (4€ per day). But don't hesitate to take yours. Electric trolleys are allowed. Using a golf cart/buggy is forbidden during practice rounds and tournament (player, caddie, coach, accompanying person)
Caddies	Caddies are allowed for the tournament. Caddies must wear flat-soled shoes. If they don't, they won't be allowed to walk on the greens.
