



2021 FRENCH TOUR QUALIFYING SCHOOL FFGOLF — PGA FRANCE

From 19th to 21st May 2021

(entries close Sunday 9th May 2021 @ 23h00)

PREAMBLE

The French Professional Commission (formed by representatives of the French Golf Federation and the French PGA) will organize the 2021 French Tour Qualifying School ffgolf – PGA France.

The Qualifying School will be opened to the foreign players filling the conditions of eligibility.

At the conclusion of the 2021 French Tour Qualifying School ffgolf – PGA France, the ranking will then allow to determine the categories member players of the 2021 French Tour.

REGULATIONS

1. FORMAT

The tournament is open to a maximum of $\underline{144}$ players, (professionals and amateurs) to be selected in the following order:

- a. Players who were in field for the French Tour Qualifying School 2020 Final Stage (cancelled tournament).
- b. Players finishing beyond 40th place of the French National Order of Merit on the 15th December 2020.
- c. Amateur players who took part in the 2020 Men European Amateur Team Championship.
- d. Players with the "1st series elite" status in 2021 in France.
- e. Players who have a category on the Challenge Tour for 2021 (from category 1 to 17).
- f. Players who have a category on the Alps Tour for 2021 (from category 0 to 9).
- q. Players who have a category on the Pro Golf Tour for 2021 (from category 1 to 10).
- h. Former winners of tournaments listed on the French Tour schedule.
- i. Players who had a category on the French Tour in 2020 or have a category in 2021 (from category 1 to 40).
- j. Order of registration (professionals and amateurs) as detailed in "2. ELIGIBILITY" below.



The French Tour Qualifying School will be played **from Wednesday 19th to Friday 21st May** at the following venue:

- Paris-Orly Airport (1h20)
- Paris-Charles-de-Gaulle Airport (1h30)
- Paris-Beauvais Airport (1h35)

The French Tour Qualifying School is scheduled to be played Stroke play over 54 holes.

After 36 holes, the field will be cut down to the leading $\underline{40}$ players and ties who will play the last round.

After 54 holes, players who make the cut and ties will be ranked according to their scores. All tied scores shall be ranked by the best last 18 holes, 9, 6, 3, and last hole.

The final ranking will determine the member players of the following 2021 French Tour categories:

- The winner of the French Tour Qualifying School: Category 17 (access to all the sanctioned tournaments "Challenge Tour", "Alps Tour" and "French Tour" in France).
- The leading 5 players of the French Tour Qualifying School: Category 20 (access to minimum two sanctioned tournaments "Challenge Tour" in France and access to all the sanctioned tournaments "Alps Tour" and the "French Tour" in France).
- The leading 20 players of the French Tour Qualifying School: Category 25 (access to all the sanctioned tournaments "Alps Tour" and the "French Tour" in France).
- Players making the cut of the French Tour Qualifying School and finishing beyond 20th place and ties of the Final Result: Category 34 (reserve category).

Every effort will be made to complete three rounds, but a result shall be declared even if only two rounds are played.

If at least two rounds cannot be played, the French Tour Qualifying School shall be partially or totally rescheduled.

Players are advised that Saturday 22nd May could be used as a full playing day.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- (1) All male professional players.
- (2) All male amateur players, with a handicap below or equal to 1.4 (handicap has to be certified by the National Golf organization for foreign players) at the closing date.
- (3) French players must have taken their ffgolf license for 2021 and provide a medical certificate.



3. PLAYING STANDARDS

Any Tournament Participant who records <u>a score of 90 or over</u> in the first round of a Tournament may be retired.

This regulation shall be implemented at the Tournament Director's discretion having taken into consideration prevailing weather conditions.

4. **HEALTH PROTOCOL** (until further notice)

To create a controlled environment and to minimize the risk of infection, these following measures include limiting the number of people on site and the mandatory Health Protocol to respect.

Everyone must bring his own masks and hand sanitizer.

You will have to upload your negative COVID-19 test (PCR) and complete the medical questionnaire online with the link provided for the registration few days after the close of entries (in May). No COVID-19 test result and medical questionnaire in paper will be accepted.

MANDATORY

Prior to coming to the venue, you must:

- Provide a negative COVID-19 test (PCR): all players, staff and swing coaches will provide a mandatory negative COVID-19 test (PCR) before coming to the venue, test realized during the last 72 hours before the previous day of the first round. As the first round will be held on Wednesday 19th May, your test must be realized between Saturday 15th and Monday 17th May included. You will not have access to the venue until your negative COVID-19 test (PCR) has been uploaded.
- Complete a medical questionnaire online.
- Download #tousanticovid app on your mobile phone.

When you are on site:

- Wear a mask in all indoor AND outdoor areas (car park, driving range access and course access) except when you play golf.
- Wash hands frequently and follow all the health measures.
- Disinfect your equipment frequently.
- Behave in a socially distanced manner at all times.

On the course:

- You must have a hydroalcoholic solution in your golf bag. Starter or COVID-19 officer
 will ask you every day to show it. If you haven't, you won't be allowed to play, and
 you will be disgualified.
- You must use your hydroalcoholic solution before touching rakes, pins, flags, stakes.

Caddies not permitted onsite:

In order to limit the number of individuals onsite, ffgolf and PGA France have decided to **not allow caddies** until further notice.

Accompanying person/swing coach:

Only one swing coach per player will be allowed. He must be registered prior to coming to the tournament venue and will be required to **respect Health Protocol** too (PCR Test, download **#tousanticovid** app and complete a medical questionnaire).



He will be permitted on the driving range and practice facilities when instructing the player, with a minimum of 2 meters from the players. He won't be allowed to caddy and to give councils and advices on the course.

5. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance measuring devices won't be allowed during the tournament (allowed during practice rounds). A yardage book in meters is included into the entry fee.

6. ENTRY ONLINE / PAYMENT

All applicants: 315 Euros.

This payment covers entry fee (290€) and yardage book (25€).

All entry registration and entry fee payment must be done and paid on: https://cpi.ffgolf.org/fr/inscription/1041

Please note that your entry will not be processed until your full entry fee has been received and banked.

7. ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries will close on Sunday 9th May 2021 at 23h00 (11.00 PM).

8. WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals must be notified to the ffgolf.

If a player withdraws prior to the appropriate closing date his entry fee will be refunded in full.

If a player withdraws after the appropriate closing date, without competing, he will be refunded only **180 Euros**. (NB: No exceptions).

If a player is absent on the tee without notification, no refund will be given, and he may face disciplinary action subject to circumstances.

Once an entrant has teed off, refund of entry is not possible.

NOTE: refunds will not be issued until close of entries.

9. NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

Once an application has been accepted, applicants will be e-mailed a confirmation of entry. The receipt of the payment of the entry fee will be available at the Tournament Office.

The final field of French Tour Qualifying School will be available on **Monday 10th May 2021** on the official website (http://frt.ocs-sport.com/tic/tmtic.cgi) and will be sent by e-mail.

The ffgolf is not responsible for your entry and it is the applicant's responsibility to verify his status in the French Tour Qualifying School.

10. GENERAL POLICY

The French Professional Commission reserves the right to change or amend the above format, conditions and schedule of play and also to reject application for entry at any time.



Conduct unbecoming a professional or non-competitive performance in a previous Qualifying School can be a basis for the rejection of the application to enter by the French Professional Commission.

11. JOINING THE FRENCH TOUR

To obtain full membership rights, players who are eligible for membership in 2021 French Tour categories, must have paid their membership fee to PGA France and ffgolf license before the 31st May 2021.

Foreign players will not be included on the French National Order of Merit 2021. They will be eligible to join the French Tour in 2022 categories only by obtaining a category by French Tour Qualifying School 2022.
